General information:

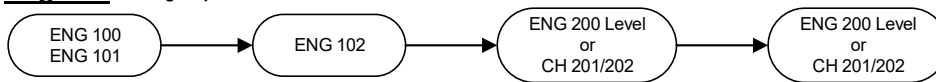
Students are responsible for their own academic plan. At NSHS, students will develop a personalized plan aligned with their chosen Bachelor's degree. This plan can lead to an Associate degree, however, NSHS does not guarantee an AA.

The following flow charts provide information to guide college planning. The following should be considered:

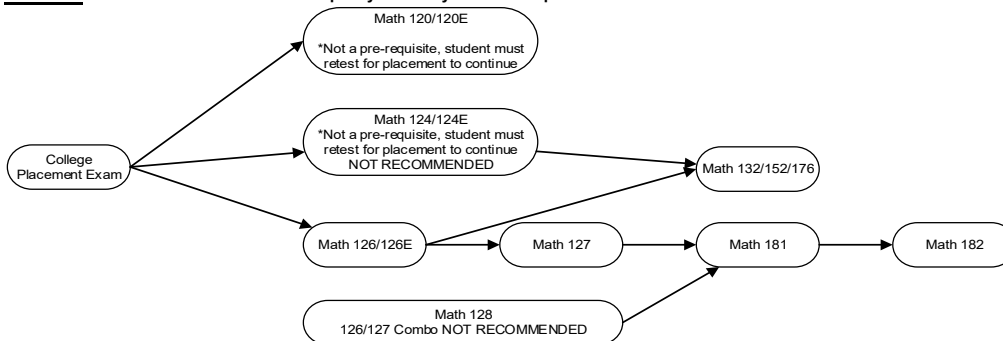
1. NSHS Academic Plan course limitations and credits
2. Current high school credit situation, completing HS requirements first, and remedial needs
3. Requirements for an Associate's Degree (if you may pursue one)
4. Specific requirements for their chosen Bachelor's Degree at a specific college
5. Students completing Math 120/120E/124/124E understand that these are NOT pre-requisite courses and do not fulfill placement requirements to continue on in Math
 - a. Students electing to take these courses must refer to the college's policies regarding retesting and course sequencing
6. Note: Flow is pending each college's outlined path per course catalog prerequisites

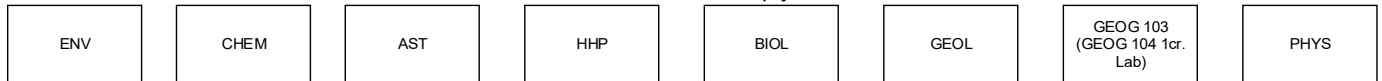
English: See degree plan to determine ENG 200 level or CH 201/202



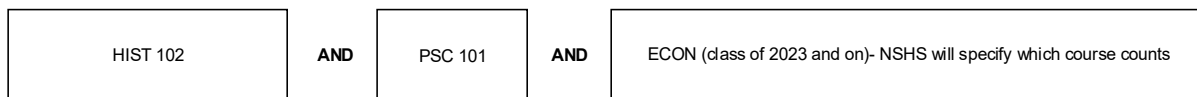
Math: Students in "E" courses do not qualify for Study Skills Exemption.
